## USEFUL INFORMATION

### **Lessons and courses at the Golf Surf School include:**

- One to one teaching with a qualified instructor
- Equipment hire (wetsuit, board)
- Civil liability insurance
- Awareness lessons on the dune environment
- Video support (for advanced courses)

### **Before the lesson**

The Surf School will contact you 7-10 days before your class with all the necessary information and the timetable.

### **Peak Season (July-August)**

The meeting point for the first lesson is at the top of the dunes at Chênes Lièges beach, at the Surf School reception next to the lifeguard post (20 minutes before the class is due to start).

We advise you to travel by bike, as there is a cycle path which will take you directly to the bottom of the dunes. If you are travelling by car, please note that the car park at the Chênes Lièges beach fills up very quickly.

### **Off-Peak Season**

The meeting point will be arranged by phone the day before, and will take place either at the Golf Surf School bus or at the beach.

Equipment will be provided for you at the beach, but please bring your own personal kit (towel, sun cream, bottle of water...).

## TERMS OF SALES

### **Article 1: Registration and reservation for surf lessons**

Any registration for a surf lesson or a service with our organisation is made using the registration form, which must be duly completed by the parents or legal guardian if it is for a minor, or by the person concerned if it is for an adult.

Enrolment in our lessons and/or courses implies acceptance of these terms.

### **Article 2: Cancellation of surf lessons**

In the event of bad weather conditions (rough seas, storms, etc.), the courses which cannot be carried out as part of the contracted service will be, in agreement with the trainees:

- Replaced by a substitute activity (learning about the environment, the equipment, ecological awareness, theory lessons, a visit to the surfboard factory)
- Postponed to a later date subject to school schedules and student availability
- Converted into a credit note valid at our surf school (schools only)
- Reimbursed as a last resort (schools only)

Deposit reimbursement terms in the event of cancellation by the client:

- Cancellations made one month before the service: entire deposit refunded
- Cancellations made less than one month before the service: the deposit will not be refunded
- Lessons not taken due to the student's fault will not be refunded
- No refunds will be made for services or courses which have been started and then interrupted

### **Article 3: Responsibility of the Surf School**

The trainees will be taken care of by the organisation and therefore under its responsibility from the moment their name is called. They remain under their responsibility until their wetsuit is put away. The civil liability of the organisation concerning its trainees ceases to operate outside of these hours outlined above. The parents or those responsible for the trainees must ensure that the planned activity is actually taking place before entrusting the trainees to the organisation.

Participants attest to having read the civil liability insurance guarantees of school and having been informed of their interest in taking out additional insurance guarantees in the event of bodily injury occurring during activities organized by the surf school (amended 1984 law). Participants are responsible for the equipment entrusted to them (boards, wetsuits, etc.) during class hours and particularly in the event of loss, theft or damage. The surf school declines all responsibility in the event of loss, theft or damage to objects which may be entrusted to it.

### **Article 4: Insurance**

All people registered at the Golf Surf School are covered by our Civil Liability and Individual Accident guarantees, the terms of which are described in the contract n°119.356.931 made available to parents or legal guardians. The school only offers these guarantees during teaching hours.

However, participants must have additional health insurance and repatriation assistance insurance. The Golf Surf School provides members with forms allowing them to take out additional insurance guarantees.

Parents or legal guardians may refuse these insurance guarantees if they consider that they are sufficiently covered by their own insurance contract, in accordance with the terms provided for by the sports law. It is understood that the participant or their legal representative acknowledges having been aware of the conditions and amount of guarantees, see Appendix, for which he acknowledges not needing to take out

additional coverage

### **Article 5: Obligations of the organisation**

The Golf Surf School accepts no responsibility for any failure to comply with the instructors' safety instructions.

Our organisation is committed to not using defective equipment or equipment with rough edges that could be dangerous. Our equipment is checked at the end of each day.

We are also committed to ensuring that our groups are as homogeneous as possible.

Finally, the quality of our teaching and our hospitality are very important to us; the Golf Surf School is committed to providing you with the best in this field.

### **Article 6: Obligations of the students**

By registering at the Golf Surf School, trainees who are minors and their parents accept the risks associated with surfing under normal conditions.

The trainee declares to be in good health, to know how to swim 25 meters, and to be fit to surf.

### **Article 7: Transport of trainees**

(In the event of use of a vehicle as part of the services offered)

The Surf School commits to ensuring the transport of trainees in compliance with current regulations:

- Drivers holding the necessary license
- Vehicle insurance coverage
- Respect for the maximum number of passengers
- Vehicle clean and in good condition (compulsory services)

### **Article 8: Image rights / Registration in the CNIL file**

By registering, you authorise the Golf Surf School to use the photos and/or films taken of you during your course, for the production of all advertising documents, without financial compensation.
